Who is eligible?

- 16 years and older; and
- Individuals approved for enrollment into the DC Justice Health Care Program through the DC Office of Victim Services and Justice Grants.

How do I access services?

You can visit any provider who accepts DC Medicaid Fee for Service. You do not need a referral from your primary care doctor. For more information on how to choose a provider, contact (202) 442-5988.

How do I get a health care card?

You will receive a health care card once your application is approved. Your health care card will arrive in the mail. If you do not receive a health care card, contact (202) 727-5355.

Can I have income and still be eligible?

Yes! There are no income requirements for this program.

Do I have to be a D.C. resident to be in this program?

No. You can receive services anywhere within the U.S. as long of the provider accepts D.C. Medicaid.
